II/General Rules and Principles

For participants in the BEMOSAIC 2021 exhibition

General principles:

- The organisation is based on the voluntary participation of the participating mosaists.
- Participation is open to all Belgian professional or amateur mosaists, international participants in order to share our passion for mosaics even further.
- Pre-registrations are received until March 30th, 2021. Each application is submitted with this completed and signed file.
- Each participant proposes two works to exhibit.
- The participants pass on: 1/ the registration form, 2/ two photos for the two proposed works, 3/ the general rules and principles duly signed.
- Given the limited number of participants, the organizers reserve the right to unfortunately refuse a registration.

The work:

- The work can use different materials according to a free assembly.
- The work communicated remains the property of their authors. The organisation reserves the right to use them for its events, its communication, its catalogue.

Before the exhibition:

- All applications will be listed. On April 10th, 2021, a confirmation of the registration will be sent by email.

- Confirmed participants are invited to pay the participation fee of 30 euros. These fees cover your participation and membership in the association.
- Registration will only be confirmed after payment of the participation fee on the bank account IBAN BE73 3631 4665 6360, ASBL BEMOSAIC, Avenue David 5, 1300 Wavre. BIC (SWIFT): BBRUBEBB.

During the exhibition:

- A collective mosaic will be created on the wall of the entrance to the Hermitage Castle.
- In-presence and virtual group workshops, and virtual conferences are held during the exhibition.
- The jury is composed of mosaists, plastic artists, architects as well as associative and institutional leaders concerned with the mosaic. The jury is organized at the diligence of the BEMOSAIC organisation.
- Jury and public prizes will be presented.
- The public is invited to visit the virtual gallery and vote and elect three mosaics of their choice.
- The jury will assess the degree of development of the work presented.

After the exhibition:

- The group of participants is invited to stay in touch and expand the group of international mosaists for future exhibitions.

The organisation reserves the possibility of refusing applications in case of non-compliance with the rules that must be submitted signed with the application.
